- » Educating Atlanta's environmental community on the important role that managed, working forests play in healthy habitat for birds.
- » Creating new market opportunities for private land by connecting forest landowners and birders.





## Addressing Forestry Workforce Challenges

- » Funding research through the University of Georgia's Carl Vinson Institute of Government to identify the scale of the forestry workforce gap and provide solutions for addressing the workforce shortages for the next 10 years.
- » Connecting with more than 500 agriculture teachers and 6,000 FFA students to provide resources, curriculum and leadership for forestry education and careers.

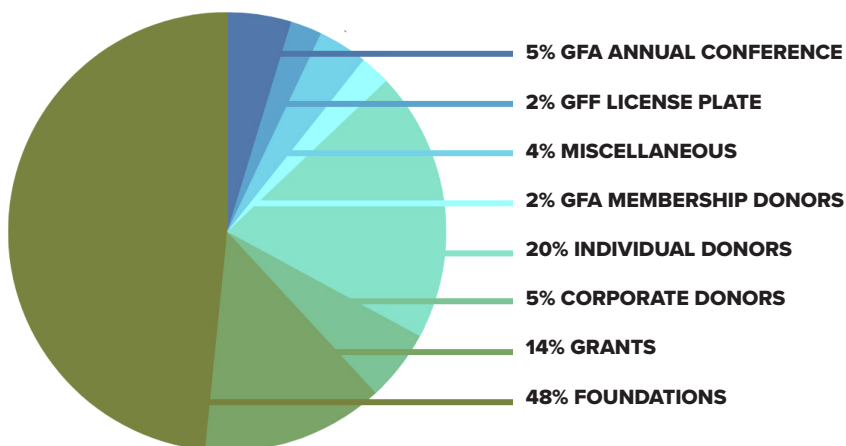

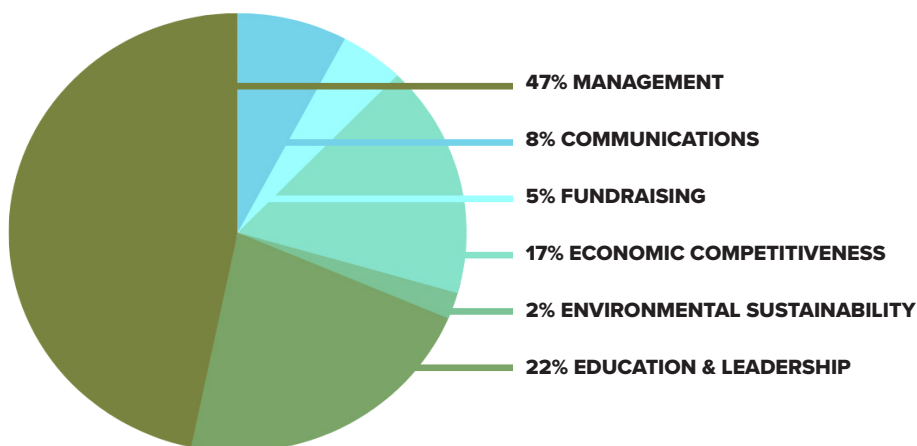
